Early Years Advice Line can be called by anyone wanting support for 0–5-year-olds. Parents, carers, families, children and young people should contact their SENCO or SENDIASS.

U Universal: Many children will find some learning and access to learning harder than others. High quality and inclusive teaching and learning practice will allow for this. Offering small group sessions, direct teaching or other support, as part of Hertfordshire's **Ordinarily Available Offer**, which can be found on the **Herts Local Offer** web page.

T Targeted: Parents and schools will work together to meet the child or young person's needs. If following assess, plan, do review cycles (usually at least two), it might be that further support needs to be sought from outside professionals and other agencies.

S Specialist: For some children and young people their needs will require individual intervention that will require more sustained involvement from professionals.
